Stitch Count: 53 H x 56 W

Fabric: Linen of your choice

Model used: 40-Count Maritime White from Lakeside Linens.

Threads: Threads of your choice

| Symbol | Weeks Dye Works Cotton Floss | DMC |
|--------|------------------------------|------|
| ■ | Blue Spruce | 3362 |
| I | Bright Leaf | 435 |
| ▲ | Emma's Pink | 962 |
| ♥ | Garnet | 777 |
| ● | Liberty | 321 |
| ♣ | Scuppernong | 3364 |

Each square on the graph equals 2 linen threads.

Cross Stitch over two linen threads: use one strand of floss.

Back Stitch the pine (bottom section) with one strand Blue Spruce.

Back Stitch / Long Straight Stitch the small fir trees with one strand Scuppernong.

Back Stitch the small fir tree trunks with one strand Bright Leaf.

Cross Stitch over-one berries (bottom section) with one strand Garnet.

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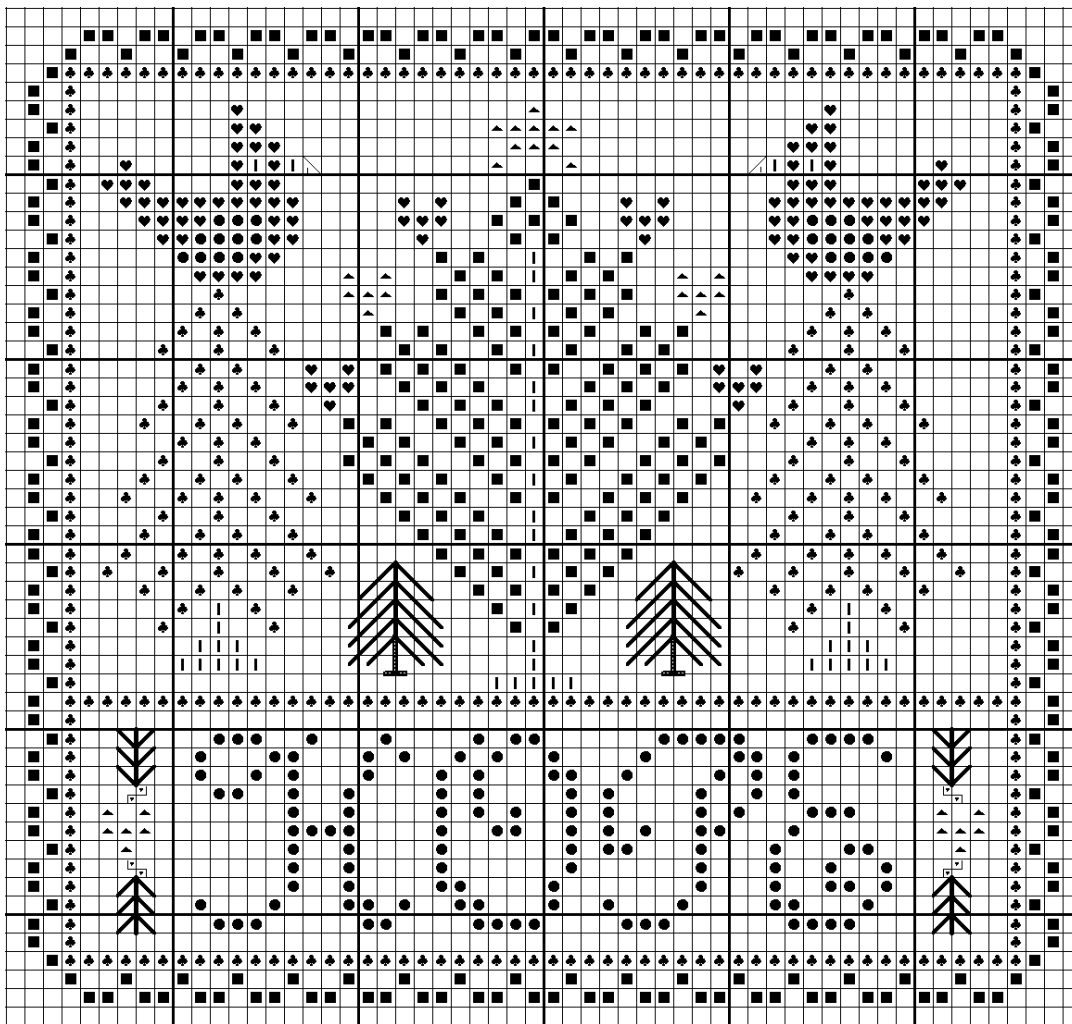
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
