







## 5. Prepare Backing

- Fuse a 6½” x 7½” piece of fusible fleece to the wrong side of the 6½” x 7½” backing fabric, following the manufacturer’s instructions.

## 6. Finish Pincushion

- Place quilted front unit with rick rack and backing fabric right sides together. Pin and sew around all four sides using a ¼” seam allowance, leaving an opening for turning.
- Clip corners and turn right side out. Carefully push out corners and press.
- Stuff pincushion to your liking.
- Hand stitch or fuse the opening closed.
- Your Cosmic Cottage Pincushion is now complete. Add needles and pins and put scissors in the pocket – place in your stitching nest. Enjoy!
